

EYELINING AFTERCARE

After discharge from this centre, you should go home and rest. You must be accompanied home by a responsible adult, and must have someone with you for the remainder of the day and overnight.

Even if you feel normal, your reaction time will be slower after receiving sedation drugs.

It is normal to feel slightly sleepy or dizzy during the first 24 hours, so:

- Do not drive a car or catch public transport
- Do not drink alcohol
- Do not operate hazardous machinery
- Do not travel alone
- Do not make important decisions or sign important documents

Do not engage in strenuous activities, including heavy lifting or sport.

WHAT TO EXPECT IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE OPERATION:

- Do not be concerned if some blood stained tears come from the wound for the first day after surgery. This is normal.
- You may experience bruising around the eyes, puffy eyes, or stickiness of eyelids for several days after the procedure.

POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS:

- You can resume normal activities after the procedure. There is no harm in using your eyes as much as you want.
- You will be given an ointment to apply to the area twice daily for the next three days.
- You may carefully cleanse around the eyelids in the morning with a moist cotton ball. Do not pick away at any crust along the eyelid. Early removal of pigment crusts may result in areas with insufficient eyeliner penetration.
- Do not use eye make-up or contact lenses for three days after the procedure. Please wait a week before resuming mascara and eyeliner.
- Avoid getting the wound wet during a bath or shower during the first week after surgery. Also refrain from swimming or excessive sun exposure for one week. If the wound gets wet, dab it dry.
